## Note Worthy Music & Drama Programs

Dear Parents of Students in Grades 3-8,

### 1. Musical Instrument: Soprano Recorder (Required for Grades 3-8)

As part of the music curriculum, students in grades 3-8 will be playing the Soprano Recorder. Each new student, student entering grade 3, or returning students who need to replace lost items must purchase the approved recorder and strap for \$6.00. Students with instruments and books from prior years may bring labeled items to the music room to be stored in the class cubby. Straps may be ordered separately or can be homemade. Students' Music grades are dependent on having the instrument in class.

Order forms for the new school year may be submitted as early as the August "Meet and Greet" orientation day/ "Supply Drop Off" day. Homeroom teachers will give your orders and payments to the music teacher and orders will be placed for what is prepaid by families at the beginning of the year. Items ordered later in the year may cost more and take longer to receive.

### 2. Full Year Chorus/Choir Participation (Optional for Grades 5-8)    ~ ~    Second Semester Option for Grade 4

At the beginning of the school year, students in **grades 5-8** are invited to join the chorus/choir at Annunciation. These students will lead the congregation in song during school liturgies, sing at Grade 8 graduation, and participate in seasonal performances before their schoolmates and families. Rehearsals are on Wednesdays from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m. (subject to change), after which students are escorted to their waiting car or to Annunciation's Extended Day service where standard charges will apply.

At the beginning of the second semester, students in **grade 4** are invited to join the chorus/choir at Annunciation as described for grades 5-8 above.

My son/daughter will participate in Chorus/Choir and we agree to abide by all school and classroom rules, attend practices and performances regularly, and pay the appropriate participation fee below. We will treat Chorus/Choir as a commitment.

### 3. Drama Participation (Optional for Grades 6-8)

In September, students may enroll in afternoon drama classes that will take place from **September** through **April** and culminate in one or two performances of an age-appropriate play/skits before their schoolmates and families. Classes on **Thursdays** are from 3:00 p.m. to 4:00 p.m., (subject to change), after which students are escorted to their waiting car or to Annunciation's Extended Day service where standard charges will apply.
