



Annunciation Catholic School's Top Ten Tips for Parents for Academic Success

1. Log in and monitor RenWeb daily for homework, tests, grades progress and specific class information.
2. Check RenWeb for the school and the class calendar.
3. Review and sign daily the student planner.
4. Check the Wednesday folder by reviewing student work and notices. Student papers are signed and returned on Thursday.
5. Support your child's good attendance by arriving on time and limiting planned absences. Coming late to school prevents a positive start to the day and also causes classroom disruptions.
6. For student absences, make note of any make-up work due or missing homework and the deadlines for this work.
7. Check the ACS handbook for uniform guidelines, especially for dress down days and cooler weather days.
8. Read the ACS weekly newsletter and all special e-mail messages from the school.
9. Classroom concerns or questions? Ask the teacher first, then the assistant principal or principal.
